Places to visit

República de los Niños (childrens republic)

Its a small town built in 1951 for children. It has different buildings that on a small scale represent state institutions such as the government house, the courthouse, the legislature, among others. It also has large green spaces, a small train that runs through the city, a small airport, a farm and mechanical games.

Meridiano V (neighborhood)

It is an old neighborhood of the city of cobblestones, low houses and street lamps where the old provincial railway station is located (today the Provincial Station Cultural Center). It is characterized by a lot of artistic life and culture. It has numerous bars where you can eat pizza, drink beer and listen to live music.

Viewpoint of the Cathedral

It presents two levels in terraces at 42 and 63 m. The elevator is totally glazed allowing the visitor the contemplation of the Temple and a global panorama of the city: the layout and foundational axis; entire view of the Moreno Square; and the River Plate Open: 11:00 to 07:00 Tuesday to Friday. Saturday and sunday 10:00 to 08:00. Monday close.

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
