3.3(b)(1) 7. THE 801ST BATTALION WAS SURPRISED TO LEARN THAT SUCH PROMINENT MONTONEROS WERE IN ARGENTINA; THE 801ST BATTALION HAS CONCLUDED THAT THE MONTONERO PRESENCE AND LEVEL OF ACTIVITY IS SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER THAN HAD BEEN BELIEVED PREVIOUSLY.
